


## **Setting up Raz-Kids**

Please notify Cindy DiStefano if you notice a student is missing from your class roster, or you have a new student as she is handling student accounts. Please do not change student usernames or passwords.






Raz-Kids is self-advancing; as students successfully complete the books at their assigned level, it will automatically advance to the next reading level.






**Book Room** – additional books the student has access to.


Customize the level of books the student has access to in the Book Room.








Raz-Kids tab details; how many times a student read a book, listened to a book, took the quiz and if they recorded themselves reading.


Select a student name for more details
